This month is we will have another great topic, Wash-CAP, founded and directed by Mr. John Waldo. John Waldo is an attorney on Bainbridge Island specializing in the unique legal needs of the Deaf and the Hard of Hearing.

Mr. Waldo first got his B.A. degree at Pomona College of California back in 1967. Later he went back to school and earned a J.D. in 1981 at the University Of Utah School Of Law.

At this present time, he can practice law in Texas, Utah and of course Washington.

Being Hard of Hearing himself, he fights for the civil rights of other Deaf and Hard of Hearing people and against employment discrimination, which leads us back to Wash-CAP; Washington (state) Communication Access Project.

Wash-CAP is a non-profit corporation which helps insures that the Deaf and Hard of Hearing know what's going on in the good hearing world. This may include ASL, or an amplified listening device, or with open and closed captioning. The law says we must be allowed to know what is going on for our safety; whether at work, or traveling by trains, planes, or ferry. The law even provides for access to fun things like plays and movies.
