Too often people living with hearing loss look to technology to solve all their communication challenges. While hearing aids, cochlear implants and assistive listening devices help, they likely do not solve all problems. Lisa will talk about factors that interfere with one's ability to understand and what you, the listener, can do to help yourself.

Lisa has been a clinical supervisor and instructor at the University of Washington for almost 4 years. Her focus is on helping individuals with hearing loss to learn strategies for improved communication. She has been an audiologist for 20 years, first coming to Seattle (from Montana) to do her internship at the VA Medical Center. She worked in several different clinical settings before coming to the University of Washington. She is married with two children, a daughter age 8 and a son age 5.
